

2017 Poster Contest Rules



- Any media may be used to create a flat or two-dimensional effect (paint, crayon, colored pencil, charcoal, paper or other materials).
- Poster size must be between 8.5" x 11" and 22" x 28".
- All posters **MUST** have the student's entry form attached to the back of the poster and must also have the student's name, teacher's name, and school's name **WRITTEN** on the back of the poster (incase the form gets detached).
- All posters **MUST** have the theme "Healthy Soils are Full of Life" written on the poster.
- Posters should be packaged so they remain flat when sent to competition.
- All posters must be created by an individual student rather than a team of students.
 - Poster should be turned in to the Gulf Coast Soil and Water Conservation District SWCD no later than **3:00 p.m. on Monday, November 6, 2017**. Posters may be mailed or dropped off at the USDA Building located at 5417 Gerstner Memorial Drive, Lake Charles, LA 70607. Office hours are M-F from 7:30am – 4:00pm.
 - Judging will occur on Wednesday, November 8, 2017 and winners will be announced Thursday, November 9, 2017.

Although younger students will most likely receive help in planning from parents or teachers, we strongly encourage each student to do as much of the work as possible by him/herself.
